Since 1946, Nashville Humane has been helping homeless and adoptable dogs and cats find their forever homes here in our middle Tennessee community. We have helped generations find their family pet. And we're proud to be the ones you think of when you go to adopt in our community. This year we helped more than 3,600 pets find their special someones and had a save rate of 99% for the fifth year in a row!





**LESLIE KNOPE**

When Leslie Knope arrived at Nashville Humane, we never would have expected six months would pass before she found her forever home. But that's our challenge every day at the shelter, and sometimes, that's what makes the adoption after the wait that much sweeter!

Leslie had a few barriers to adoption, which kept her list of likely adopters limited. She was a strong, large-breed dog who loves

people, but just didn't care for other pups. But a challenging adoption doesn't slow the team at NHA down, not one bit! In fact, it only motivates us to work harder to help them find their forever someones. Ultimately, it would take a combination of time at the shelter and then time in one of our special Foster Ambassador homes until her day finally came. Leslie found her people and her people found Leslie! It was love at first lick and now she's living her best life in a loving home.

## OODLES OF DOODLES

At the height of the summer, we were contacted about a large group of 45 dogs that were in dire straights. We all know “doodles” because they’re downright adorable, but the popularity of this type of dog has led to puppy mills, overbreeding, and these bad breeding practices usually end up with dogs in pretty poor condition. That’s where NHA comes in.

These dogs needed a place to go with resources and the ability to care for them.

And we couldn’t turn away a situation this distressed. While cute and adorable, nearly every single one of the adults from this transport, and two additional transports, 108 dogs in total, had severe behavioral and/or medical trauma. It would be months before the last ones would finally find their forever someone’s. But they did, because our amazing pet-loving community stepped up, and now there are oodles and oodles of doodles getting a second chance at a good life.

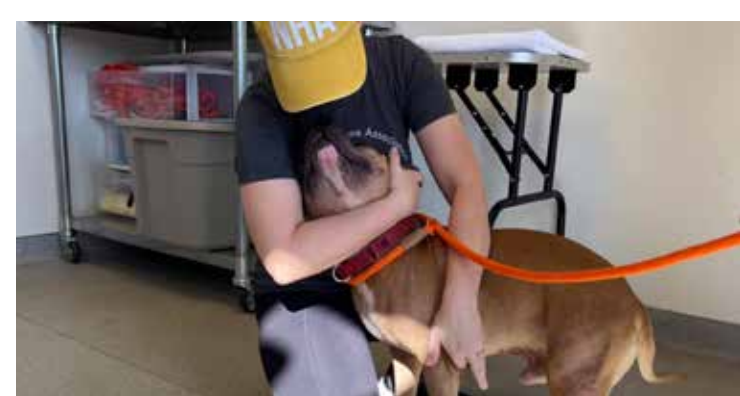




## HURRICANE IAN

In the fall of 2022, Hurricane Ian, a devastating category 4 storm ripped through Florida destroying nearly everything in its wake. When disasters like these strike, often times we're asked to be a "shelter of refuge" and help transport pets into our care and out of harm's way. This time, in partnership with our friends at Humane Society of the United States, we brought 21 little furry friends into our care from Manatee County, FL., which was ground-zero where Ian made landfall.

NHA's Transport Program exists because of gifts from our supporters. We're able to say "yes" time-and-time again because we know that your support makes all of this happen. These little ones were safe from the storm and found their special someone's right here in Music City because of generous contributions made to NHA. We've dedicated ourselves to providing food, resources and assistance to help not only pets, but pet families in our community. Our goal is to help keep pets out of shelters and in their homes, where they belong!





## LOW-COST CLINICS

Beginning in the summer of 2022, Nashville Humane piloted a series of low-cost Vaccine and Microchip Clinics across Davidson County. Our mission as NHA is to not only help amazing pets find forever homes, but also support our unbelievable pet-loving community. Many families simply do not vaccinate or microchip because these services can be expensive if performed in a Vet office.

If Nashville Humane can help provide a

safe, accessible, and affordable microchip and vaccine solution to the public, then we're keeping pets safe, healthy, and in their homes and out of shelters... right where they belong! We are driven to provide these essential services to our community and help remove barriers to pet ownership. Moving forward into 2023, thanks to your local support and a \$20,000 grant from the Banfield Foundation, NHA will be able to expand these clinics and offer them monthly for an entire year!

## YETI & COLEMAN



Yeti and Coleman were two little sweethearts who were found abandoned in our donation bins outside the shelter's front doors. Far too frequently we are seeing more cases of animal abandonment right on our doorstep. While processing donations, one of our Animal Care Techs heard a faint noise and pulled these two out of the bin before they were crushed by a 30 pound bag of food. Once they made it inside, the medical team immediately got to work.

They were malnourished, dehydrated, and both had severe upper respiratory infections. But they were fighters and they went off into a loving foster home where they were able to recover and grow stronger. Our fosters are amazing people who open their hearts and homes to pets and truly do save lives. Thanks to their foster family, Yeti and Coleman are now big and strong and in their loving forever homes!

LILA SUE

Lila Sue came to our shelter as one of the four pups in the “Star Wars” litter. The Star Wars litter, originally named Yoda, Princess Leia, Anakin and Obi-Wan were four tiny little pups that were abandoned and left to fend for themselves. We were notified of four small little malnourished and sick pups and immediately sprung into action.

Cases of animal neglect and abuse are difficult because they can so easily be

avoided. When they came to Nashville Humane all four had been out in the peak summer heat with little to eat, and all four had severe cases of Demodex mange, a skin condition caused by parasitic mites that can be potentially fatal if untreated. These four were such sweethearts, including Princess Leia (now Lila Sue). Even though it was humans who had let them down, all four were absolutely in love with people and our staff.



Lila Sue would eventually grow to fall in love with Lindsay one of our amazing NHA Volunteers. Volunteers at NHA are the core foundation of all of the work that we do. Volunteers give their hearts, their time, their energy and they do it all for the love of shelter pets and because they believe in our mission. And in this case, a volunteer gave a pup with a pretty sad start to her story, a second chance at a great life!

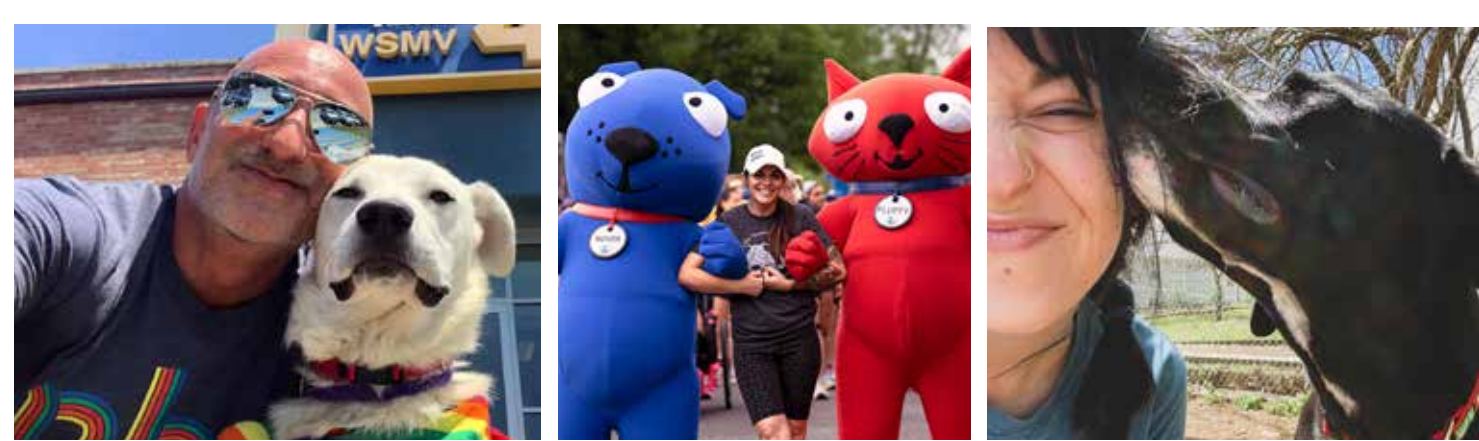

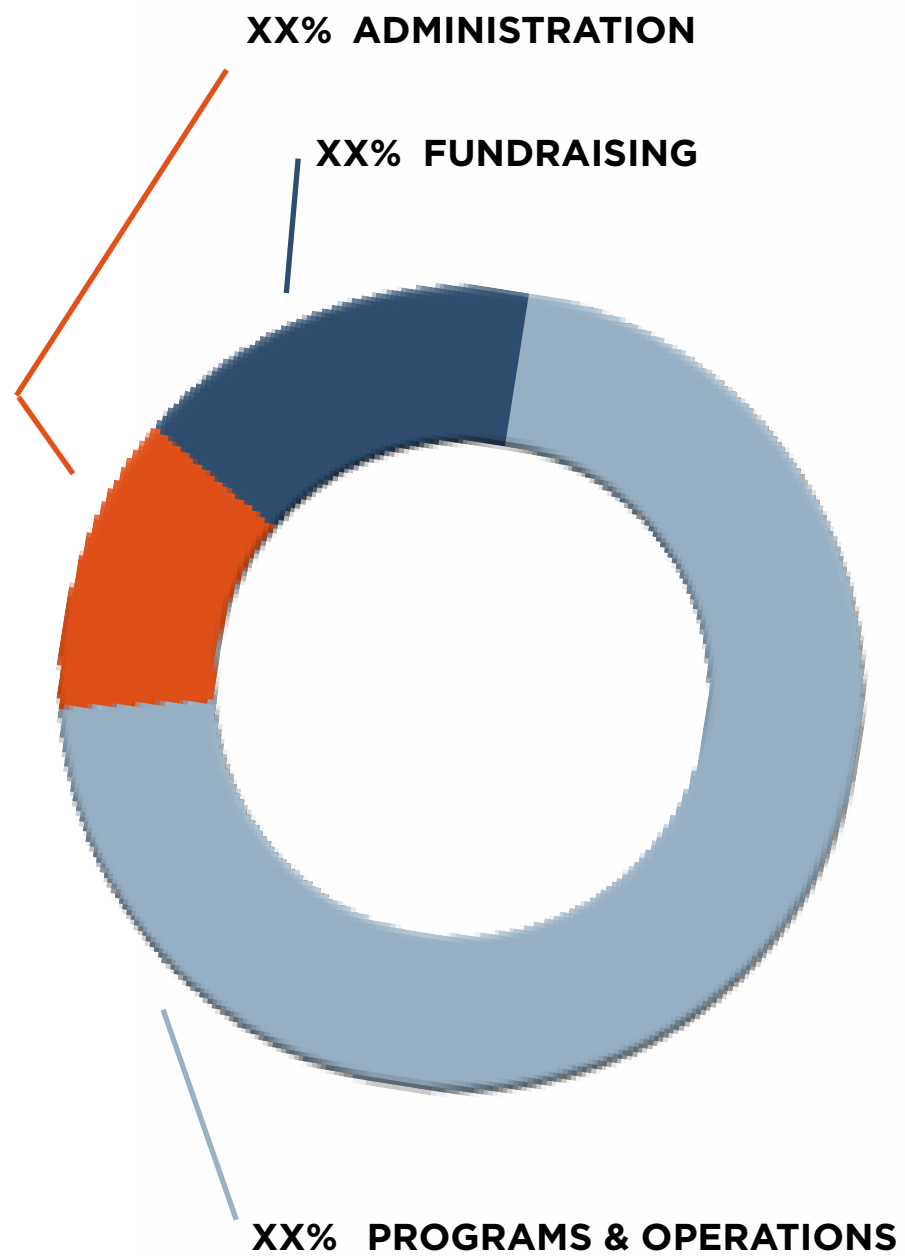
